- 10 Dedicate it as reoccurring annually? this can be done in leg in some places, can be limiting to future

- 12 every year
- 13 This bill leaves it up to the administering agency to decide if they want to subgrant the program out
- 14 or not. This can be defined. Some states that require it also include waivers to normal contracting
- 15 processes (for intention of speedy implementation) this should be decided based on trust in the
- 16 administering agency to run the program well. If there isn't it may be useful to lay out the
- 17 requirements: must issue RFA by X date, select winner by Y date, report back on Z date, etc. And
- 18 should also define what you are looking for in a sub-grantee.
